## Subject: Status of the SHARE Scholarship Programme

Dear Colleagues,

Greetings from SHARE!

We refer to the letter that was sent to your institution in April 2018, regarding the continuation of the SHARE Programme, and in particular the SHARE Scholarship Programme. As you may be aware, on 4 January 2019, SHARE will end its current programme phase, and with that the SHARE Scholarship Programme. We have communicated to you that ASEAN and the EU have expressed their strong interest for the continuation of SHARE, and discussions between the two partners are ongoing on ways to continue the SHARE Programme.

Thus far, discussions between the two partners have been positive and we expect the extension phase of SHARE to be formalised soon. To keep the momentum going, we are pleased to announce that batch 5 of the SHARE Scholarship is scheduled to be implemented in the second semester of the current academic year 2018-2019 (January – August 2019) for Intra – ASEAN mobility. The scholarship application and selection is scheduled to take place from **28 September 2018** until **2 November 2018** through the SHARE CTS Platform <https://www.share-asean.org/> as previous practises. However, due to time constraints, ASEAN-EU mobility will not be made available at this time. We would appreciate if all participating universities make internal preparations as appropriate, to facilitate the implementation of the scholarship programme and to be communicated to students, faculties and staffs of your institution.

While we expect batch 5 of the SHARE Scholarship to go ahead as planned, this is still subject to final agreement of the extension by ASEAN and the EU. Updates will be posted on the SHARE CTS Platform.

We would like to thank you for your continued support and your participation in this unique project. We do hope that your participation has benefited your university by supporting further internationalisation of your institution, and more specifically by providing study abroad opportunities for your students and workshops for your international office staff.
