## Frequently Asked Question

### Q1. What responsibilities do I have in this program?

A1: The partner company sponsors your scholarship during your study period; therefore, you are obligated to work for the company after graduation in accordance with the scholarship terms.

### Q2. Is there any restriction for age?

A2: Since the needs of industries vary, please confirm with your desired university

### Q3. I intend to apply for an English-taught program. Why do I need to take Mandarin courses in this program?

Achieving A2 level in TOCFL is essential for your future in Taiwan. If you plan to enroll in an English-taught class, you must reach TOCFL A2 or higher by your second year to qualify for a tuition fee waiver scholarship.

<sup>(1)</sup> The INTENSE Program Awardee will receive automatic coverage of their tuition fee for the first year. However, if they are enrolled in an English-taught class, they must achieve a TOCFL A2 certification before entering the second year to be eligible for tuition fee waiver scholarship

<sup>(2)</sup> For the support related to Airplane Tickets and Administrative Expenses. They should keep the receipts to request for **reimbursement** from the university once they arrive in Taiwan.

**Details for Administrative Expenses:** Visa, Medical Check Up, Document Legalization
